Approval of Minutes

The meeting minutes from May 14, 2020 were approved by Marcia Jones, M.D.

Discussion

The meeting was started at 1229 via Zoom by Natalie Cruse.

The annual meeting is to renew the Biotronik humanitarian device used in the CGH catheterization lab when the patient has a rupture of the vessels in their heart during a cardiac procedure in the catheterization lab. Natalie reported the device has not been used in the last year. Dr. Marcia Jones will sign the letter, for the Biotronick devices, for approval for the next year.

Natalie gave updated information on the 2020 FMT transplants. Due to COVID and FDA regulations, there was a pause in shipping until further notice in July 2020, with notification at that time to quarantine the current stock until further notice. Since then, our current stock has outdated, but we do have credit from the company, for the outdated stock. Currently, the company is not taking any orders at this time, other than emergency cases. We had one patient who received FMT in 2020, and they are doing well.

There was further discussion on the circumstances of the decrease in data, whether it is due to COVID and FDA regulations, if there are other options available, or whether there is a need for FMT. Data from 2021 may be able to resolve these variables.

No other studies were discussed.

There being no further business, the meeting ended at 1237.
