LIFESAVING MEASURES RECOGNIZED

It was standing room only at the Rock Falls City Council meeting held on Tuesday, February 21. Rock Falls Police Chief David Pilgrim presented awards to three police officers and four civilians for their lifesaving measures that took place on January 6 at Rotary Airlock.

"I am proud of our officers quick response and the bystanders who started CPR immediately," said Rock Falls Police Chief David Pilgrim. "The AEDs that were used were donated by the CGH Health Foundation in 2019 for use in the squad cars."

Chester Hilty, former owner of Rotary Airlock for 26 years and still active in the business, suffered

a ventricular fibrillation that led to cardiac arrest. CGH ambulance crew members, Stacey Roberts and Jason Schneider, along with the Rock Falls Police Department and the Rock Falls Fire Department, responded to the cardiac arrest. With the collaborative efforts of these departments, the Twin Comm dispatcher and bystanders, Hilty survived the cardiac event.

"It was a collective effort and true reflection on how each link in the chain of survival works. This starts with bystander CPR, pre-arrival instructions from dispatch, early defib by officers and fire, and subsequent ALS interventions," said Ryan Venema, CGH Director of Pre-Hospital Care and Ambulance. "Without the actions of everyone involved, the outcome would have been negative. Kudos to all responders involved!"

Lifesaving Awards were handed out to Rock Falls Police Sergeant Doug Wolber, Officer Autumn Day, and Officer Matthew McKanna and four Rotary Airlock employees who first called 911 dispatch and started CPR.
