

PPE USE WITH CLOSE CONTACTS:

Patients reporting as close contacts (known exposure to COVID+ person >15 minutes within 6 feet) place in Airborne Contact Precautions. DO NOT admit to COVID Unit.

WHAT PPE DO I NEED?

This algorithm should be initiated upon "rooming" or entering the patient's room.



^{**}If patient has previous (+) test, see CMH Discontinuation of Isolation Precautions.

DROPLET PLUS vs. AIRBORNE CONTACT

PPE LEVEL	DESCRIPTION	VISUAL
Droplet Plus	Mask AND appropriate eyewear. * Use gown/gloves with direct patient contact (i.e., toilet/transfer). *see CMH Eyewear Protection – COVID Related Strategies	
Airborne Contact	PAPR or N95 <u>AND</u> full-face shield or gasket goggles <u>AND</u> gown/gloves.	

^{*} Gown and gloves are required when adequate distance cannot be maintained AND during the implementation of an aerosol-generating procedure.
