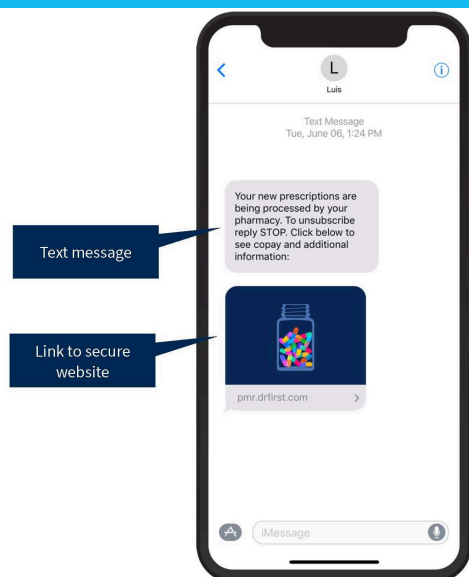

# How does the Rx Text Work?



**Patients receive a text message (SMS) 10 minutes after the e-prescription is sent to the pharmacy.**

**The text message contains a link to a secure website that lets patients view information related to their pharmacy and new prescriptions.**

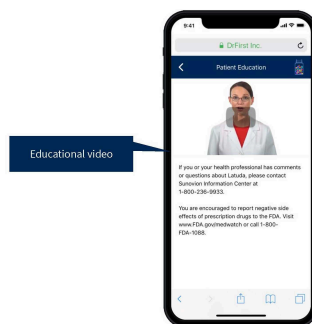

## Rx NOTIFICATION TEXTS

We have a new prescription text service (Rx Notifications from DrFirst) we provide to our patients that have provided us with their cell phone number (at registration).

If you have provided your cell, you will receive a text message 10 minutes after your e-prescription is sent to the pharmacy.
