



GCHP Membership Growth


Fiscal Year 2011 - 2020




Membership by Supervisorial District




Member Age

Quality Services

- In 2018, GCHP reported improvement in 33 of the 40 quality of care metrics that the Plan reports annually to the state Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA).
- In 2018, GCHP scored in the 75th NCQA percentile for the measure on Weight Assessment and Counseling for Nutrition and Physical Activity in Children and Adolescents and in the 90th NCQA percentile for the Immunizations for Adolescents (combo 2) measure.
- GCHP successfully passed the NCQA Health Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) Compliance Audit[™] for the seventh consecutive vear.
- GCHP is collaborating with Ventura County Medical Center on two quality improvement initiatives to improve the health of adults diagnosed with diabetes and increase childhood immunizations.
