Re: World Immunization Week - "Protected Together"
Date: April 27, 2018
Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) values the health of its members and encourages practitioners to reduce child immunization gaps in Ventura County by scheduling their patients for immunizations.

The World Health Organization has designated April 24 to 30 as World Immunization Week. This year's theme, Protected Together, highlights the collective action needed to ensure that every person is protected from vaccine-preventable diseases.

Vaccines are one of the most successful and cost-effective health interventions and they have dramatically reduced the threat of many infectious diseases that were once widespread and fatal. Despite the evident benefits of vaccines, Table 1 shows that GCHP's HEDIS ${ }^{\circledR}$ rate for the Childhood Immunization Status (CIS) Combo 3 measure has decreased. The current rate of 64.96 ranks at the $25^{\text {th }}$ national percentile.
