Re: Gold Coast Health Plan Network Outage: August 18

Date: August 17, 2020

On Tuesday, Aug. 18, Gold Coast Health Plan's (GCHP) computer network will be unavailable for several hours because of a planned power outage. Southern California Edison, in coordination with GCHP's property management company, will be shutting off the power from 4:30 a.m. - 8:30 a.m. as part of their required work to protect public safety. To safeguard GCHP's technical equipment and systems, *GCHP must turn off its entire computer network from about 3 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.*

Because the outage will overlap with GCHP's business hours, certain systems will be unavailable, including paper-based faxes and local GCHP phone lines.

During the outage:
