Re: Physician Advisory: Oseltamivir/Tamiflu® Availability During Flu Season

Date: February 15, 2018

Gold Coast Health Plan is issuing a physician advisory regarding the availability of Tamiflu<sup>®</sup> during this flu season.

## Oseltamivir/Tamiflu<sup>®</sup> availability may be limited this year.

Pharmacies may be having trouble-obtaining oseltamivir (generic Tamiflu<sup>®</sup>) and branded Tamiflu<sup>®</sup> due to increased demand during the current influenza season.

## What has GCHP done to address this issue?

GCHP has adjusted its formulary to cover both brand and generic products without needing to request a prior authorization or override.

## What can providers do?

If a pharmacy is unable to provide oseltamivir/Tamiflu<sup>®</sup> for your patient, please direct your patient to contact another pharmacy.
