Changes to the Immunizations in Adolescents HEDIS® Measure

Effective for the 2016 measurement year, the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) has added the *Human Papillomavirus Vaccine for Female Adolescents (HPV)* to the *Immunizations for Adolescents (IMA)* measure. The purpose for this change is to measure the administration of five recommended vaccines for adolescent males and females in one measure.

Vaccines Required for the Immunizations in Adolescents HEDIS® Measure

The IMA measure will now evaluate the percentage of 13-year-olds who had the following five vaccines by their 13th birthday:

Table 2: Requirements for the IMA Measure

Required Vaccines	Required Dose	Date Range Vaccines Must Be Administered
Meningococcal conjugate	1	Between the 11 th and 13 th birthday
Tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis (Tdap)	1	Between the 10 th and 13 th birthday
Human papillomavirus	3	Between the 9 th and 13 th birthday

To ensure your clinic scores high on the IMA measure, please ensure your 13-year-old patients have completed all five recommended vaccines within the required time frames listed in Table 2.
