Re: **Medi-Cal Program Provider Enrollment**

Date: April 4, 2018

Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) received an all-plan letter (APL) from the state Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) stating that all contracted Managed Care Plan (MCP) providers are required to be enrolled in the Medi-Cal program **by December 31**.

Per APL-17-019, to remain under contract with GCHP, **all providers** must enroll in the Medi-Cal program. To ensure GCHP's compliance with the APL, the Plan will be screening records to determine which providers are enrolled. Going forward, the Plan will be re-validating its records on a monthly basis to ensure compliance.

All providers who are not enrolled in the Medi-Cal program must submit their enrollment form to DHCS by May 1. This allows time for DHCS to process the application.

Providers who are not enrolled in the program by December 31 will be terminated from the GCHP network.

DHCS has different enrollment applications depending on the type of provider / facility. You can find more information on the Medi-Cal Provider Enrollment page under, '**Paper Applications, Instructions and Requirements.**'
