Re: Medi-Cal Rx Training

Date: April 7, 2021

The state Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) released a guide that outlines the trainings that will help pharmacy providers, prescribers, and their staff as they transition to Medi-Cal Rx. Although the implementation of Medi-Cal Rx is on hold until further notice, DHCS is encouraging providers to prepare for the transition by registering for access to the secure portal.

The following trainings are available now:

- User Administration Console (UAC) Training (April August 2021): Job aids and computer-based tutorials (CBTs) are available to walk users through the registration process.
- Saba LMS Training (April August 2021): Learn how to view the Education and Outreach events calendar, how to register to attend an event or take an online course, and how to complete evaluations of training effectiveness.
- Medi-Cal Rx Transition and Resources and Web Portal Training (starting April 2021): Provides pharmacy providers and prescribers with an overview of the Medi-Cal Rx transition and the resources that are available on the Medi-Cal Rx web portal.

Additional trainings will be available prior to the implementation.
