Re: CHDP Program Well-Child Exam Schedule

Gold Coast Health Plan (GCHP) values the health of its members. The Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) program is a state and federally funded program that provides periodic health examinations and services to low-income children and youth.

Results of our HEDIS[®] 2016 quality reviews show that many children enrolled in the CHDP program are receiving their well-child exams every two years instead of annually.

Ventura County's <u>CHDP Eligibility Assessment Schedule</u> indicates that children and youth between the ages 2 to 20 should receive preventive care exams annually. The <u>American Academy</u> <u>of Pediatrics</u> also recommends annual physical exams beginning at birth.

As a primary care physician, you are required to provide preventive health care according to nationally recognized criteria. The required components of preventive care exams include:

- Health history
- Developmental and behavioral assessments
- Nutrition and physical activity assessments
- Sensory screenings
- Physical examinations
- Oral health
- Health education/Anticipatory guidance

Please schedule your patients for their preventive care exams annually in accordance with AAP and CHDP guidelines.
