Brokopp Family Healthcare Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Grant Regional Health Center Foundation, Lancaster, WI, will award <u>two \$2,500 healthcare scholarships</u> on behalf of the Brokopp Family to successful applicants in 2022.

Eligibility to apply: Those eligible to apply include individuals beginning or continuing their enrollment in a <u>healthcare</u> program at a fully accredited two- or four-year college between late May and Fall of 2022.

Priority will be given to residents of Grant County, especially those in Cassville, Fennimore, Lancaster, Potosi or River Ridge school districts **AND** attending UW-Platteville, UW-Madison, or Southwest Technical College with an interest to return to the Grant Regional Health Center service area after completion of their education. Individuals who previously received a GRHC Foundation scholarship are not eligible to apply for a second time.

A selection committee will evaluate applicants for two - \$2,500 healthcare scholarships based on their:

- intent to pursue a career in the healthcare profession;
- academic achievement (grades and class standing);
- involvement in school and/or community activities;
- commitment to their chosen field;
- demonstrated integrity and work ethic.

Deadlines:

Applications are due on or beforeApril 1, 2022Awards will be announcedMay, 2022 (can vary based on award ceremonies)

Upon award of the scholarship:

The applicants selected to receive a scholarship in 2022 will sign an agreement with GRHC Foundation outlining the conditions for release of funds. Payment will be made after the committee receives verification/transcript that the student has successfully completed one semester of the course/program. (\$1,250 after the first semester and \$1,250 after the second semester). The recipient is responsible for obtaining this verification. The recipients of the scholarship will be provided the contact information of the donor of the scholarship and expected to provide the donor a short thank you note and description of their educational and career plans.
