Re: Sample Medication Distribution

Dear Provider:

KHS actively discourages Providers from providing sample medication to members. However, if given, the samples must cover the entire course of therapy. Also, please note non-formulary medication provided as samples **do not**: establish a continuity precedent, satisfy step therapy criteria (when a formulary alternative is used first), and do not obligate coverage by KHS.

The Provider is also required to document the following information in a Sample Medication Log as well as in the patient medical record:

- A. Patient name
- B. Drug
- C. Dose
- D. Route
- E. Number distributed
- F. Manufacturer
- G. Lot number
- H. Expiration date
