Re: Proposition 56 Directed Payments for Family Planning Services APL 20-013

Dear Provider:

Assembly Bill (AB) 74 allocates Proposition 56 funding to support family planning services. Network and out-of-network Providers may bill the appropriate CPT code to be eligible for directed payments for conducting the following family planning services. Please refer to APL 20-013 for more information on the qualifying family planning services and payment.

- Emergency contraceptives when provided as a medical benefit
- Long-acting contraceptives
- Sterilization procedures (males and females
- Other contraceptives (other than oral) when provided as a medical benefit
- Pregnancy testing

The goal of the program is to enhance quality patient care by offering an enhanced payment structure to qualified health care delivery providers who offer family planning services.

Payment will be made ninety (90) calendar days from the date of receipt of the clean claim or accepted encounter which meets the criteria outlined in APL 20-013. General claim processing rules apply.
