Synagis Impact Related to Managed Care to Medi-Cal RX Benefit Transition

Effective January 1, 2021, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is transitioning Medi-Cal pharmacy services from the managed care delivery system to the Fee-For-Service delivery system known as Medi-Cal Rx. The transition will impact the injectables for Synagis (Palivizumab) used in treating RSV, or Respiratory syncytial (sin-SISH-uhl) virus.

RSV, is a common respiratory virus that usually causes mild, cold-like symptoms. Those at greatest risk for severe illness from RSV include:

- •Premature infants
- •Very young infants, especially those 6 months and younger
- •Children younger than 2 years old with chronic lung disease
- •Children younger than 2 years old with chronic heart disease
- •Children with weakened immune systems
- •Children who have neuromuscular disorders, including those who have difficulty swallowing or clearing mucus secretions than 1 year of age in the United States.

Kern Health Systems will continue to review and authorize medically necessary Synagis injections beginning in October through December 2020. Claims will be paid via the KHS Pharmacy Benefit (PBM) until December 2020. After January 1, 2021, new requests or claims for dates of service after 12/31/2020 will be processes by Medi-Cal RX.
