APL 22-010 (OPL) Guidance Regarding Assembly Bill 1184 – Confidentiality of Medical Information

Dear Provider,

The Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) released APL 22-010 due to AB 1184, which amends the Confidentiality of Medical Information Act. AB 1184 requires health plans and providers to protect the confidentiality of a member's medical information, including but not limited to:

- Directing communications regarding a protected individual's receipt of sensitive services as follows:
 - Directly to the protected individual's designated alternative mailing address, email address, or telephone number; OR,
 - In the absence of a designated alternative mailing address, email address, or telephone number: to the address or telephone number on file in the name of the protected individual.
- Not disclosing medical information related to sensitive health care services provided to a protected individual to any member other than the protected individual receiving care, absent an express authorization of the protected individual.
- Approving and accommodating requests from any member for confidential communication in the form and format requested, if readily producible in the requested form and format, or at alternative locations.
