## APL 22-018 Skilled Nursing Facilities – Long Term Care Benefit Standardization and Transition of Members to Managed Care

Dear Provider,

As part of the Cal-Aim Initiatives, Long Term Care (LTC) services will be carved-in as part of Kern Health Systems (KHS) responsibility.

Effective <u>January 1, 2023</u>, KHS will be responsible for the full LTC benefit at the following facility types and homes:

Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), including a distinct part or unit of a hospital;

Effective <u>July 1, 2023</u>, KHS will be responsible for the full LTC benefit at the following facility types and homes:

- Intermediate Care Facility (ICF)
- Intermediate Care Facility for Developmentally Disabled (ICF-DD);
- ICF-DD/Habilitative;
- ICF-DD/Nursing;
- Subacute Facility;
- Pediatric Subacute Facility.

The goal of the Medi-Cal LTC carve-in is to better integrate care across institutional and home-and community-based settings. Requests can continue to be submitted through the KHS Provider Portal.
