California Children's Services – Physical & Occupational Therapy

Dear Provider,

Before referring a KHS member <u>under the age of 21 years old</u> for physical or occupational therapy, please check to see if the patient has a CCS condition.

- To determine if the member has a CCS condition, please access the California Children's Services (CCS) Provider Electronic Data Interchange Portal at:
 - o https://cmsprovider.cahwnet.gov/PEDI/login.jsp
- If it is determined that the member <u>has</u> a CCS condition, and that is the reason you are referring the member for therapy, please fill out a Service Authorization Request (SAR) and send it directly to <u>CCS</u>. <u>Do not refer the member to any therapy providers directly</u>.

- If it is determined that the member <u>does not</u> have a CCS condition, or if the therapy is not in relation to the CCS condition, the member can be referred directly to any in-network KHS physical or occupational therapist. Please note, KHS does not require prior authorization for physical or occupational therapy unless the requesting provider is a tertiary facility or a non-contracted provider. It is important to remember to check the prior authorization list the first of each month as changes are made monthly.
- If your office receives a Notice of Action (denial from CCS) you can refer the patient directly to any contracted KHS physical or occupational therapist for services.
