Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Provider Training on February 10, 2026

Dear Provider,

We are sharing the following training opportunity on behalf of our partners at Kern County Public Health.

Kern County Public Health will be hosting a virtual **Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Provider Training on Tuesday, February 10, 2026**. This training is intended for health care providers and clinical teams who serve pediatric patients and families.

The training will cover:

- Current childhood lead exposure risks
- Recommended screening and testing practices
- Clinical follow-up and care coordination for elevated blood lead levels
- Local and state resources available to support prevention and management

The goal of the training is to strengthen early identification, prevention efforts, and appropriate clinical response to reduce the long-term health and developmental impacts of childhood lead exposure. CMEs and CEUs are available to clinical participants.
