### Pharmacy Scope Guide

Dear Provider:

As a reminder some medical devices and supplies are billed to Kern Health Systems (KHS) and some are billed to Medi-Cal RX. This bulletin is a reminder where to submit prior authorization requests and who should be billed for services provided/rendered. **As a reminder, Kern Family Health Care members may never be charged for a covered service.**
