## All Plan Letter (APL) 22-031

## **Doula Services**

Dear Provider,

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) released APL 22-031 on December 22, 2022, to provide guidance regarding doula services which are aimed at preventing perinatal complications and improving health outcomes for birthing parents and infants.

## Covered Doula Services, effective January 1, 2023:

Doula services can be provided virtually or in-person in an office setting, house, hospital, or alternative birth center. Although prior authorization is not required, a recommendation for doula services must be requested in writing and will include the following services:

- One (1) initial visit
- Up to eight (8) additional visits that can be provided in any combination of prenatal or postpartum visits
- Support during labor and delivery (including labor and delivery resulting in a stillbirth), abortion, or miscarriage
- Up to two extended three-hour postpartum visits after the end of a pregnancy

\*If additional services are needed, a written request must be sent to the doula.

## Below are examples of some Non-Covered Doula Services

Belly binding (traditional/ceremonial)	Birthing ceremonies (i.e., sealing, closing the bones, etc.)	Group classes on babywearing
Massage (maternal or infant)	Photography	Placenta encapsulation
Shopping	Vaginal steams	Yoga
