



Early Periodic Screening Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT)

Care Management/Care Coordination Referral Form

The Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) benefit provides comprehensive and medically necessary services needed to correct and ameliorate health conditions for children under age 21. EPSDT includes periodic screening, vision, dental and hearing services.

When diagnostic and/or treatment services are indicated, as a result of a screening, the primary care physician (PCP) can refer the patient to Kern Health Systems (KHS) for care coordination. The KHS Care Coordinator offers assistance if the patient is having problems navigating the health care system. The KHS Care Coordinator helps with transportation, locates appropriate resources, and assists in arranging support services.
