Medi-Cal Rx Physician Administered Drug (PAD) Operations

Dear Provider,

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) recently updated language regarding coverage of the Physician Administered Drugs (PADs). PADs can be considered either a medical or pharmacy benefit. There are some drugs that considered to be predominantly a medical benefit and therefore would be expected to be billed as such. These will reject with an error NCPDP Reject 816 and require a prior authorization for consideration. The Medi-Cal Rx Provider Manual has been updated to reflect this. Appendix H has been added listed the drugs that this section applies.
