Kern Health Systems is excited about mid-year push to increase our MCAS compliance. The year is flying by, but KHS MCAS Measures have shown significant improvement from last year.

The mid-year push is going to focus on increasing MCAS measures that are extremely close to Minimum Performance Level – Our focus will be on:

- Immunizations for Adolescents Combination 2* IMA
- Lead Screening in Children (LSC)
- Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life 0 to 15 Months Six or More Well-Child Visits (W30-6+)
- Well-Child Visits in the First 30 Months of Life 15 to 30 Months Two or More Well-Child Visits*
 (W30-2+)
- Chlamydia Screening in Women (CHL)
- Breast Cancer Screening (BCS)
- Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)

The MCAS Team at Kern Health System will support your team in any way possible to meet MPL.
