Medi-Cal RX Vaccine Information

Medi-Cal has modified how pharmacy administered vaccines will be processed effective 1/1/2022

Dear Plan Pharmacy,

Effective January 1, 2022, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is transitioning Medi-Cal pharmacy services from the managed care delivery system to the Fee-For-Service delivery system known as Medi-Cal Rx. The transition includes:

- Outpatient Pharmacy Claims (Including vaccines)
- Authorizations
- Appeals
- Customer Service regarding any item/service transitioned from KHS to Medi-Cal Rx

Kern Health Systems will no longer be responsible for the following pharmacy benefits:

- Medi-Cal Covered Outpatient Drugs (Including drugs which are infused)
- Identified Medical Supplies
- Enteral Nutritional Products

The DHCS has clarified all components of a vaccine administered in a pharmacy, drug, administration, and dispensing fee will be billed on a pharmacy claims through the PBM.

Today: Claims are billed through KHS PBM 1/1/2022: Claims will be billed to Medi-Cal RX
