Message from the **CEO**

Lake Regional Health System is a place of intentional excellence. We take pride in our achievements and look for opportunities to celebrate all that the Lake Regional team has accomplished together.

In FY 2019, Lake Regional welcomed 20 new providers, including an oncologist, two orthopedic surgeons, a urologist and an obstetrician-gynecologist. We opened our new Women's and Children's Unit, which includes our new Family Birth Center, and opened the newly renovated Outpatient Services department. We also opened a new primary care clinic and a new Express Care clinic in Lebanon and began offering specialty outreach in Lebanon, as well.

We continued to expand and strengthen our services. Lake Regional earned designation as a Level II STEMI Center, making ours the only hospital between Springfield and Columbia to be a state-designated center for heart attack, stroke and trauma. We added 3-D mammograms and a da Vinci X robotic surgery system, and we began performing spinal surgeries. We also completed a Community Health Needs Assessment and Implementation Plan to identify and then address the top health needs in the lake area, including mental health, substance abuse and an inability to pay for medical care.

Meanwhile, we received several recognitions for the quality of our care, including national recognition for stroke care; five-star ratings from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services for Home Health and Skilled Nursing; and a Center of Excellence award for the Wound Healing Center.

At Lake Regional Health System, improving lives is at the center of all we do. On behalf of Lake Regional's board of directors, physicians, employees and volunteers, I am pleased to present the FY 2019 "Currents: A Report to the Community."

Highlights

Heart Care

During a heart attack, time is critical At Lake Regional, patients with certain acute heart attacks known as STEMIs receive treatment an average of 40 minutes faster than the national guideline — this makes Lake Regional faster than nine out of 10 hospitals nationwide. Such quick care increases patients' chances for survival and helps minimize damage to the heart, leading to more thorough recoveries.

In May 2018, Lake Regional was among the first hospitals to become a Level II STEMI Center. The State of Missouri gives this designation to hospitals that have staff and resources ready to treat heart attacks 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Lake Regional was already a Level II Stroke Center and Level III Trauma Center. Now, we are the only hospital between Springfield and Columbia to be a state-designated center for all three

emergencies. Lake Regional received heart attack patient transfers from other facilities in FY 2019 and rarely needs to transfer a heart attack patient to another facility — just once in all of FY 2019. Lake Regional cares for heart attack patients from a wide area, from Rolla to Sedalia.

Lake Regional also provides nonemergency heart care, including scheduled heart surgeries. Altogether, in FY 2019, there were 1,156 heart procedures performed at Lake Regional, including 185 vascular procedures and 157 pacemaker surgeries.

Surgical Services

In October 2018, Lake Regional installed the da Vinci X robotic surgery system. This new technology helps surgeons perform minimally invasive procedures with greater precision. Lake Regional surgeons have used the da Vinci for prostate cancer, kidney cancer, hernia repair,

colon resection, spleen removal, gall bladder removal and urinary tract conditions. Potential benefits include quicker recoveries, less pain and minimal scarring.

Also in October 2018, patients began receiving less exposure spinal surgeries at Lake Regional Hospital. These procedures include single-level lumbar microdiscectomies and laminectomies and single-level anterior cervical discectomies and fusion.

Now in Lebanon

Lake Regional Clinic – Lebanon and Lake Regional Express Care -Lebanon opened in September 2018.

These clinics share a building with Lake Regional Occupational Medicine - Lebanon, which opened in 2017. In addition, Lake Regional orthopedic surgeons and a cardiologist also provide outreach there.

Lake Regional is the only hospital between Columbia and Springfield that is a state-designated center for heart attack, stroke and trauma care.



During fiscal year 2019, Lake Regional Hospital Auxiliary raised \$78,000 to help remodel the Lake Regional Outpatient Services, which includes ambulatory surgery.

Altogether, 143 Auxilians volunteered 41,708 hours. Volunteers staffed The Shoppes, offering gifts, coffee and snacks to visitors and employees. They also served in visitor information areas and other roles throughout the

hospital and with Lake Regional Hospice.

The Auxiliary also administers the Ethel Rayburn Nursing Scholarship program, which began in 1979. During this fiscal year, the Auxiliary awarded \$7,500 in scholarships to deserving employees pursuing nursing careers. Many Lake Regional employees have benefited from this scholarship program.
