Maui Memorial Medical Center (219 beds)

Maui Memorial Medical Center is Joint Commission Accredited, a Hawaii State Designated Level III Trauma Center, a certified Primary Stroke Center, and the only acute care hospital on Maui. Services offered include:

Kula Hospital (123 beds)

Located 3,000 feet above sea level on the majestic southwest slopes of Haleakala, Kula Hospital is a critical access hospital offering urgent and limited rural emergency care for Maui's growing upcountry population. Kula Hospital offers skilled nursing and long-term care services and special nursing services for individuals with intellectual disabilities.
