Maui Health is a not-for-profit organization that provides high-quality, patient-centered, affordable care for all residents and visitors on Maui and Lanai. Its system of community hospitals and clinics are supported by Kaiser Permanente's industry-leading technology systems, evidence-based medicine, and nationally recognized quality care. Maui Health has more than 1,600 employees and partners with hospital-based physicians, clinicians and community-based primary and specialty physicians in neuro, cardiothoracic, orthopedic, vascular, and trauma surgery.

Governance

Maui Health is a non-profit, tax exempt, 501(c)(3) limited liability corporation, governed by a board of directors which includes representatives from the Maui community. The board is responsible for guiding strategy and overseeing hospital quality.

Additionally, during the COVID-19 pandemic, Maui Health opened one of the county's largest vaccine clinics, administering over 82,000 vaccines to our community.

Maui Memorial Medical Center is Joint Commission Accredited, a Hawaii State Designated ACS Level II Trauma Center, a certified Primary Stroke Center, and the only acute care hospital on Maui. Services offered include:

Maui Memorial Medical Center Outpatient Clinic

Maui Memorial Medical Center Outpatient Clinic services the community with specialties such as cardiology, interventional cardiology, cardiothoracic surgery, infectious disease, nephrology, neurosurgery, oncology, orthopedic surgery, primary care, and vascular surgery. Other services include x-ray, stress ECHO, ECHO's, 3D mammography, and laboratory services.

Maui Memorial Wound Care and Hyperbaric Therapy

Maui's first and only comprehensive wound care outpatient clinic provides the advanced treatments needed to quickly heal non-healing and difficult-to-heal wounds, including hyperbaric oxygen therapy (HBO), a Medicare-approved treatment proven to advance wound healing capability. Our team of specialists are dedicated to healing wounds, preventing limb loss, and giving patients the best possible outcome.

Kula Hospital (123 beds)

Kula Hospital is a critical access hospital offering urgent and limited rural emergency care for Maui's growing upcountry population. Kula Hospital offers skilled nursing, short-term rehab, and long-term care services, and is the only Intermediate Care Licensed Facility (ICF) in the State for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Kula Hospital has earned five-stars, the highest possible rating, from Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and is named one of U.S. News & World Report's Best Nursing Homes for 2024, ranking them at top of all nursing home/long-term care facilities in the State of Hawaii.
