Maui Memorial Medical Center Outpatient Clinic services the community with specialties such as cardiology, interventional cardiology, cardiothoracic surgery, infectious disease, neurosurgery, oncology, oncological surgery, orthopedic surgery, and vascular surgery.

Kula Hospital (123 beds)

Located 3,000 feet above sea level on the majestic southwest slopes of Haleakala, Kula Hospital is a critical access hospital offering urgent and limited rural emergency care for Maui's growing upcountry population. Kula Hospital offers skilled nursing and long-term care services, and is the only Intermediate Care Licensed Facility (ICF) in the State for individuals with intellectual disabilities. Kula Hospital has earned five-stars, the highest possible rating available in the nation, from Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) for providing the highest quality care and is ranked at the top of all nursing home/long-term care facilities in the State of Hawaii.
