Transparency in Coverage

The Transparency in Coverage rule was finalized in 2020 and it requires that insurers and group health plans provide access to information about the cost of a covered service before receiving care. There are three phases to the requirements of the Transparency in Coverage rule which are highlighted below.



Phase 1: July 1, 2022

Machine-Readable File Access

MercyCare Health Plans has posted machine-readable files in JSON file format. These files will contain pricing information for covered items and services. (See below for machine readable files.)



Phase 2: Jan. 1, 2023

Price Comparison Tool for 500 Items and Services MercyCare Health Plans is providing a self-service tool through MyChart called Cost Calculator (Under Menu > Insurance > Cost Calculator) in order for members to receive estimates. Members can also request a paper copy.

The Cost Calculator empowers members to receive an estimate of their costsharing responsibility for a specific item or service from a specific provider or providers. It covers 500 items and services.

Phase 3: Jan. 1, 2024
