- A list of all trips outside the U.S. for the last 5 years.
- Family information for **All** children and spouses (current and former).
- Certified court records if arrested and/or cited.
- 2017 Income Tax or proof of Public Benefits (such as food stamps, cash aid, SSI, etc.) to apply for Fee Waiver or Reduced Fee.
