**Subject:** Proposition 56 supplemental payment program updates (additional family planning codes, \$200 trauma screening incentive, end of Value Based Payments)

Dear Primary Care Providers,

You are receiving this communication to pass along **three** important updates. The **first** is to share that three additional codes have been added to the list of family planning services eligible for Proposition 56 supplemental payments. These codes will be included in the September 2022 payment distribution, retroactive to dates of service defined below, and will persist as long as funded via the State budget. The new codes, rates, and applicable dates of service include:

Code	Rate	Date of Service (on/after)
J7304, U1	\$110.00	January 1, 2022
J7294	\$301.00	January 1, 2022
J7295	\$301.00	January 1, 2022

The **second** is SCFHP is continuing to provide a **\$200 incentive**, made payable to the tax identification number we have on file, **to providers who complete the ACEs Trauma Screening training** linked below. Assuming eligibility, completion of the ACEs Trauma Screening training would also make available the \$29-per trauma screening Proposition 56 supplemental payment. **The following two steps must be completed** to receive the \$200 incentive <u>and</u> the \$29-per service payment:

- (1) Complete the ACEs Trauma Screening training available at https://bit.ly/3cdlJTm, and
- (2) Attest to the completion of training at <u>https://bit.ly/3R8NvjD</u>.

The **third** and final is the Value Based Payment (VBP) portion of the Proposition 56 supplemental payment program <u>ended</u> on June 30, 2021. VBP services performed after June 30, 2021 are not eligible to receive Proposition 56 supplemental payments.
