RE: Initial Health Assessment Billing Codes and Requirements

Dear Providers:

This memo provides information regarding appropriate billing codes and requirements for completing an Initial Health Assessment (IHA) for Santa Clara Family Health Plan (SCFHP) Medi-Cal, Healthy Kids, and Cal Medi-Connect members.

The IHA is another name for an initial wellness visit. The Department of Health Care Services requires the IHA to be completed <u>within 120 days of enrollment with SCFHP</u>. If necessary, the IHA may be completed during a sick visit if the following IHA components are conducted:

- Comprehensive history
- Complete physical and mental status exam
- Preventive care
- Diagnosis and plan of care
- An assessment of health behaviors via the Staying Healthy Assessment (SHA) form

The visit should also include an oral assessment, immunizations, tuberculosis risk assessment, and other ageappropriate screenings based on American Academy of Pediatrics and United States Preventive Services Task Force guidelines. Preventive health guidelines can be found in Section 21 of the SCFHP Provider Manual, available at <u>www.scfhp.com</u>.

In the event the IHA does not occur within 120 days of enrollment, the missed appointment(s), phone or letter contact attempts to schedule or reschedule, and/or member/parent refusal should be documented in the medical record. For patients who are new to SCFHP but are your existing patients with an established medical record, a previous well visit may count as an IHA if it was conducted within the last 12 months.

New member rosters are accessible through SCFHP's provider portal. Rosters should be reviewed monthly to identify new members and conduct outreach to schedule the IHA within the required timeframe.
