Subject: SCFHP/Valley Health Plan Responsibility – Long-Term Care Member Update

Dear Provider,

Santa Clara Family Health Plan (SCFHP) and Valley Health Plan (VHP) have recently updated their authorization and claims agreement for long-term/custodial care. The following changes are effective for dates of service beginning **January 1**, **2019**. Please forward this communication to all appropriate staff at your facility.

- VHP continues to be responsible for long-term care (LTC) authorizations and claims for the entire month of an SCFHP member's LTC admission.
- Responsibility for LTC authorizations and claims will transfer to SCFHP the month after admission.

If the member continues their LTC stay for a second month, a <u>Long Term Care Authorization</u> Request Form must be submitted to SCFHP. The request can be submitted before responsibility transfers from VHP to SCFHP. Please be sure to include the SCFHP start date on your request. For example, if the LTC month of admission is during the month of January 2019, the start date for the SCFHP LTC Authorization Request is February 1, 2019
