Dear Providers:

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) clarified that Medi-Cal Managed Care Plans must cover podiatric and chiropractic services when provided by Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Rural Health Clinics (RHCs). For more information please see the DHCS All Plan Letter 15-003 on the <u>DHCS website</u>.

Effective July 1, 2009, DHCS discontinued optional Medi-Cal podiatric and chiropractic services, with certain exceptions. Additional exceptions will be added for the provision of podiatric and chiropractic services at an FQHC and RHC. The Medi-Cal Provider Manual will be updated to reflect these new exceptions, in addition to the existing exceptions to the 2009 elimination of these services.
