This letter explains changes to your Healthy Kids HMO insurance. The program is also known as the County Children's Health Initiative Program (CCHIP).

Dear Member,

This letter is about changes to your Healthy Kids HMO insurance. This includes health, mental health, dental, and vision insurance.

What will change?

Starting October 1, 2019, children enrolled through Santa Clara Family Health Plan's Healthy Kids HMO will move to Santa Clara Family Health Plan's Medi-Cal program.

- 1. Health and Vision Insurance will be provided by Santa Clara Family Health Plan's Medi-Cal program.
 - \circ Your child can still see the same health care provider.
 - \circ $\,$ There are no co-pays for prescriptions or for doctor visits.
 - Your only cost is your monthly premium payment.
- 2. Dental Insurance will be provided by Medi-Cal Dental.
 - Your child may see any dentist who accepts Medi-Cal Dental.
 - Please ask your child's dentist if they accept Medi-Cal Dental.

What will not change?

- 1. Your child's covered benefits will not change. Your child will not lose any health, dental, mental health, or vision benefits.
- 2. Your child's Healthy Kids HMO health care provider will not change.
- 3. Your child will stay with Santa Clara Family Health Plan.
