Subject: Administration of Long-Acting Injectable Antipsychotics

Dear SCFHP Provider,

Long-acting injectable antipsychotics can be administered in a physician's office, mental health facility, or pharmacy. California licensed pharmacists may administer drugs by injection when ordered by a prescriber, as outlined in California Business & Professions Code, Section 4052.1(a)3. If administration in a physician's office or mental health facility is not available, please consider referring your patient to a pharmacy that is able to administer injectable antipsychotics. Not all pharmacies are able to provide administration.

Listed below are network pharmacies that offer injections without additional administration fees or costs. Please confirm drug availability with the pharmacies in advance.
