Subject: NEW Claims Editing Software

Dear Plan Partners,

As of November, 1 2022, Santa Clara Family Health Plan (SCFHP) has implemented a new claims editing software for all lines of business. The new software will be effective for claims processed on or after November 1, 2022. The software has been implemented to ensure that claims processed by SCFHP comply with Medi-Cal, Medicare, local coverage determination (LCD), national coverage determination (NCD), and the National Correct Coding Initiative (NCCI) guidelines (as applicable).

While we may have previously allowed some common billing errors to be paid, they will be denied moving forward.

Some examples of possible denials:

- Invalid modifiers
 - oSL modifier for VFC vaccines
 - oKX modifier for DME
 - oLT/RT modifiers
 - o51 modifier for multiple procedures
 - oTransportation pick-up/drop-off modifiers on non-transportation services
- Invalid diagnosis codes
 - oDiagnosis codes must be to the highest specificity
 - oThey must be valid for patient age and gender
