Dear Santa Clara Family Health Plan Providers,

We are pleased to announce that we will continue to offer the Provider Performance Program (PPP) in 2023. In support of changes made by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), PPP measures have been updated and featured below.

PPP 2023 Measures

1. Cervical Cancer Screening (CCS)
2. Chlamydia Screening in Women (CHL)
3. Controlling Blood Pressure (CBP)
4. Developmental Screening in the first Three Years of Life (DEV)
5. Hemoglobin A1c Control for Patients with Diabetes (HBD) >9.0%
6. Initial Health Assessment (IHA)
7. Lead Screening in Children (LSC)
8. Plan All Cause Readmissions (PCR)
9. Prenatal & Postpartum Care (PPC-PRE) – Timeliness of Prenatal Care
10. Well-Child Visits in the first 30 months of Life: Members with six or more well-child visits in the first 15 months of life (W30-15)
11. Well-Child Visits in the first 30 months of Life: Members with two or more well-child visits between 15 months and 30 months (W30-30)
12. Child & Adolescents Well Care Visits (WCV)
13. Follow-up After Emergency Department Visit for Substance Use (FUA)
14. Follow-up After Emergency Department Visit for Mental Illness (FUM)
