

## CARES Act Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund Disclosure Statement

1. Southeast Missouri Hospital College of Nursing and Health Sciences has signed and returned to the Department of Education the Certification and Agreement under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act. The institution intends to use no less than 50% of the funds received to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students. Further, the institution has designated a portion of 18004(a)(2) and 18004(a)(3) for the purpose of awarding Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
2. The institution has been designated to receive \$65,755 from 18004(a)(1) for the purpose of awarding Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students. Further, the institution has designated \$2,424 from 18004(a)(2) and \$40,000 from 18004(a)(3) for the purpose of awarding Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
