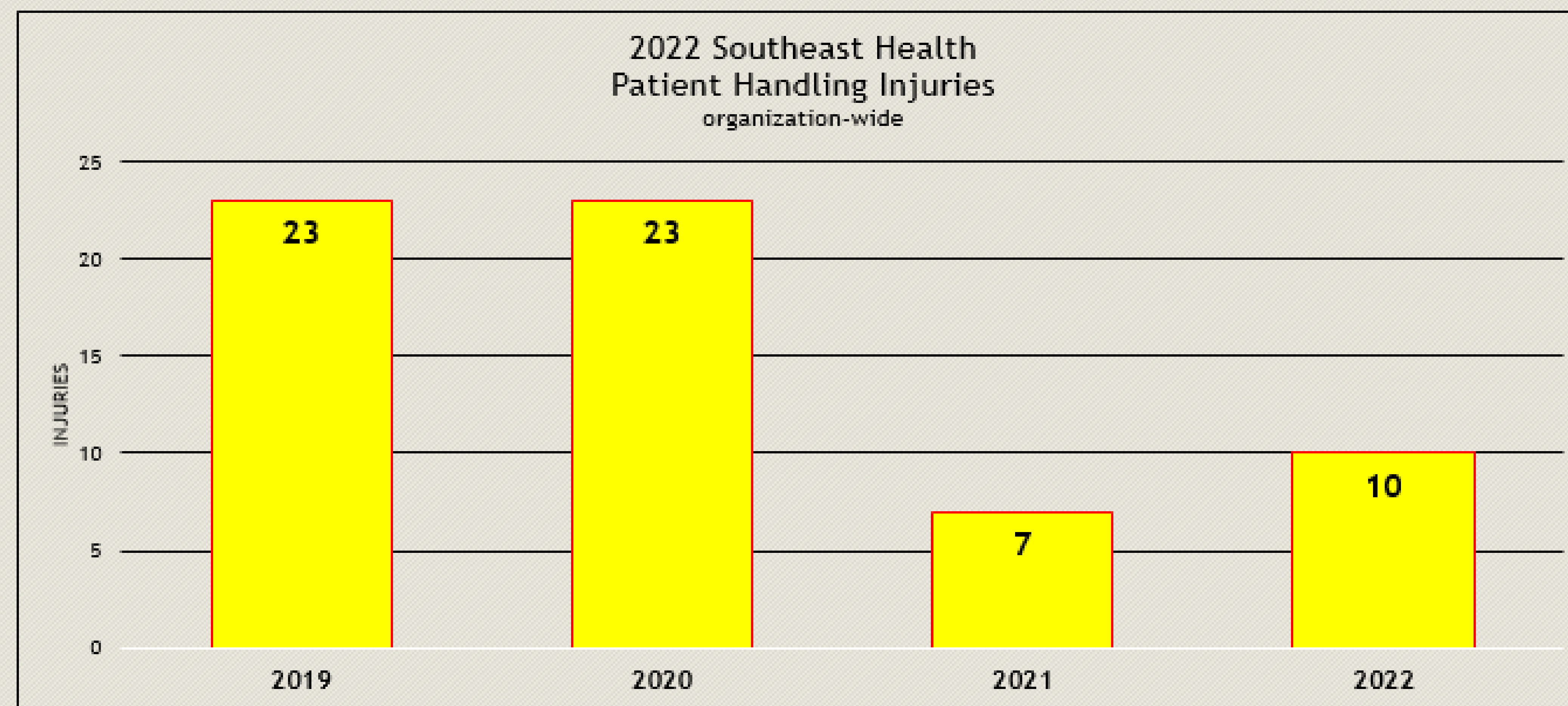

- Added distance markers to nursing units & purchased 5 bed extenders

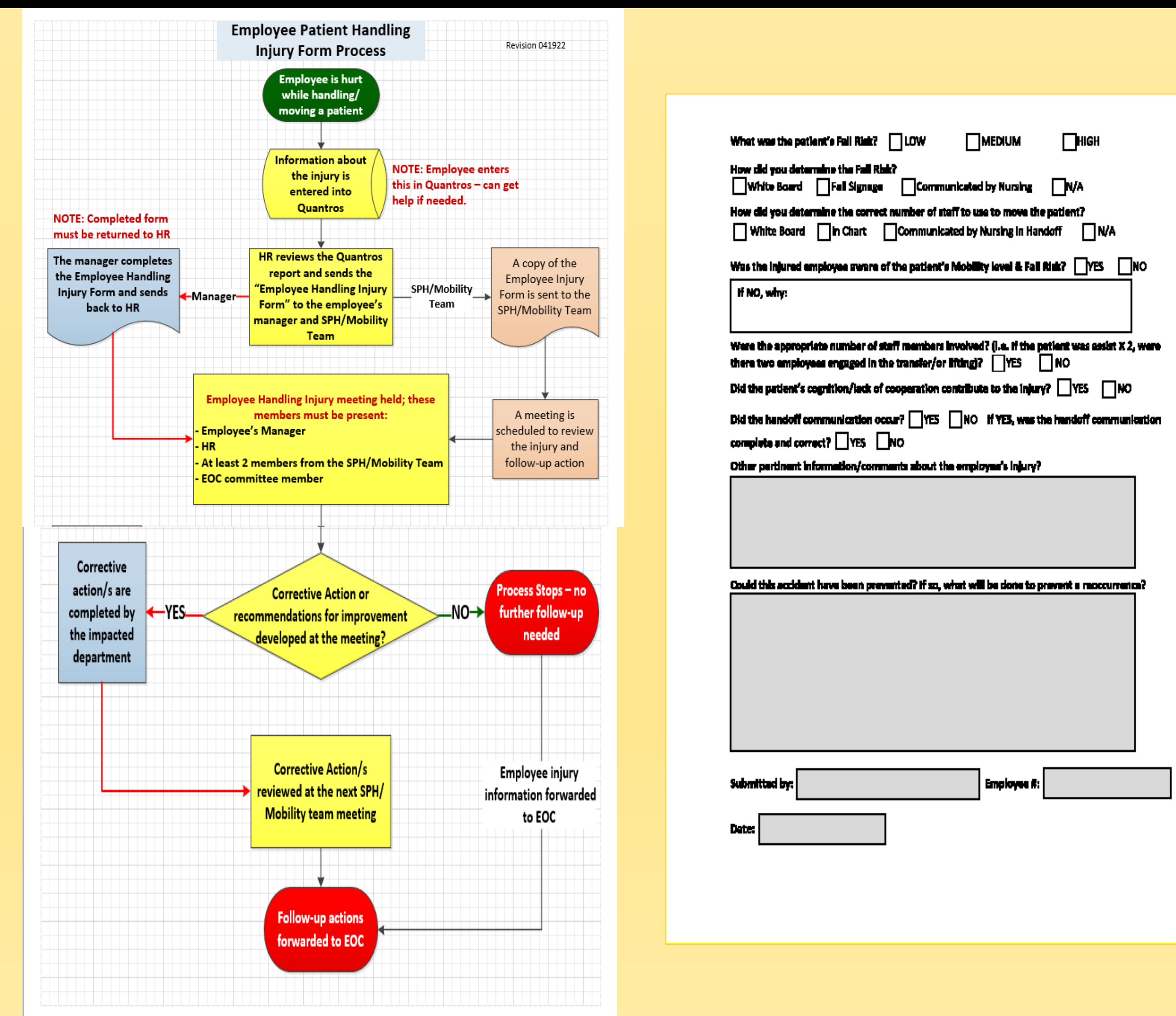
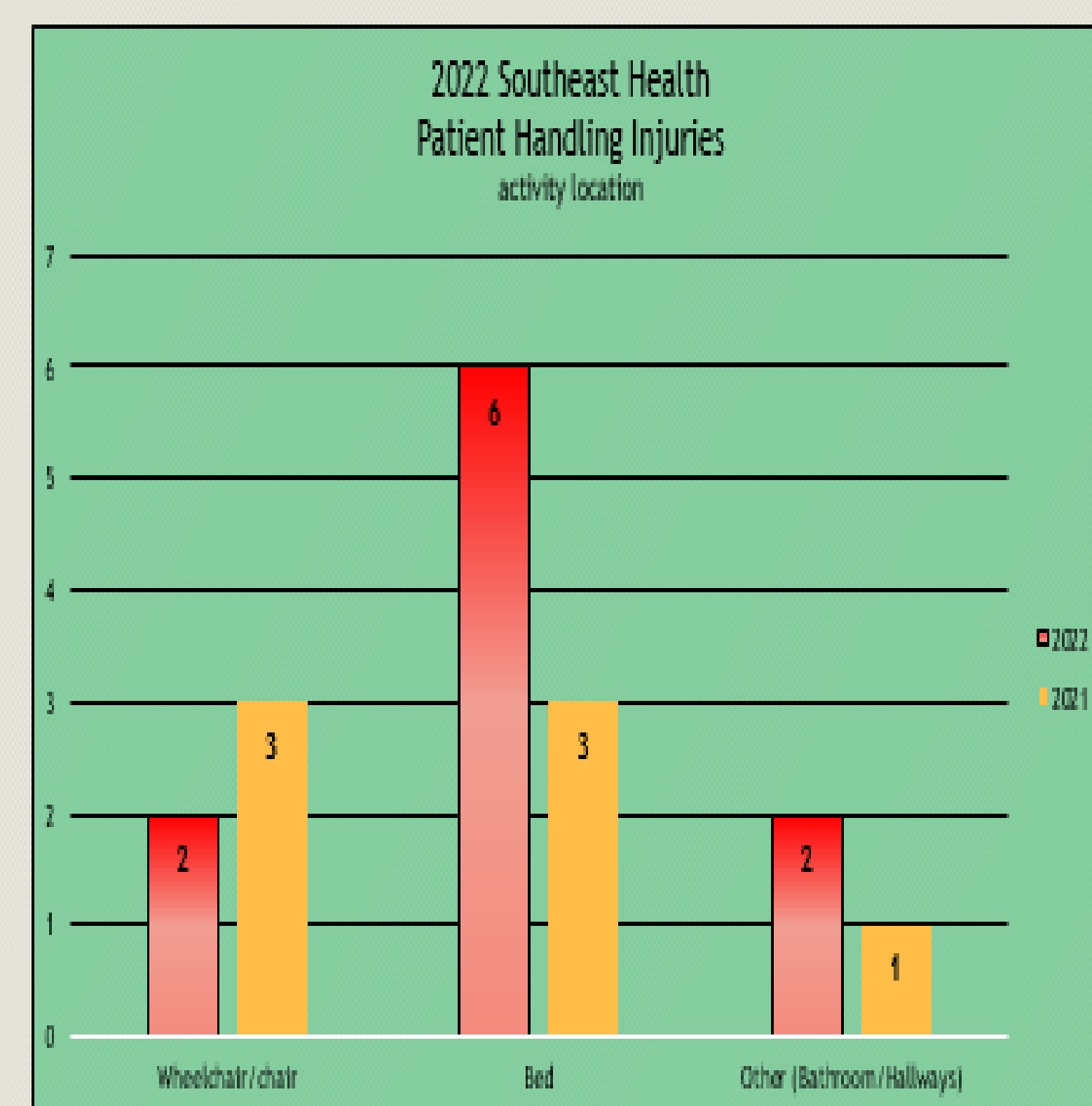
