Who Is a Good Fit for Acute Rehabilitation?

For certain patients, acute rehabilitation is the best setting for intensive treatment toward recovery and a return to independence. Patients who benefit from intensive care in an acute rehab setting may have experienced the following:

- Major multiple trauma
- Stroke
- Brain injury
- Spinal cord injury
- Hip or femur fractures
- Total hip replacement
- Total knee replacement
- Amputations
- · Cardiovascular or pulmonary issues
- Neurological conditions such as multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, motor neuron diseases, polyneuropathy or muscular dystrophy
- Orthopedic conditions
- Burns

A pre-admission assessment screening is conducted to assess each patient's appropriateness for the program.





Care in an Acute Rehab Setting

Once the patient's functional status has been identified, a treatment plan prescribed by the physician is implemented, and an individualized plan of care is developed. The care delivered in an acute rehab setting includes:

- interdisciplinary, patient-centered treatment approach by a team of highly-qualified rehabilitation professionals
- on-site medical director to coordinate and manage the efforts of the interdisciplinary rehabilitation team
- treatment from rehab professionals with training and understanding required to treat medically complex patients
- training to return to independent walking
- minimized risk of readmission to the hospital from complications that may arise during rehabilitation treatment
- intensive therapy

With an emphasis on recovery, our rehabilitation experts provide innovative treatment approaches to assist patients in returning to a normal lifestyle. Our rehab professionals include occupational therapists, certified occupational therapist assistants, physical therapists, certified physical therapist assistants, speech-language pathologists, nursing staff and physicians.
