ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The part-time paramedic to Registered Nurse (RN) bridge track of the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing is an evening/weekend track designed to build upon the previous experience and coursework of the student. The program prepares students for the National Council Licensing Examination for Registered Nursing (NCLEX-RN) and incorporates valuable hands-on opportunities throughout clinical and classroom settings along with individualized instruction from faculty. Upon completing the program, students are prepared to work in a variety of settings and/or transition into a BSN completion program.

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Cumulative high school OR college GPA of 2.50 on a 4.0 scale
- ACT composite score of 21 or SAT score of 1060 (only if age 22 or younger)
- Minimum one year of paramedic work experience
- Current paramedic license






