TEAS INFORMATION



Overview

The Assessment Technologies Institute Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI-TEAS) is a computer-based test that is designed to assess a student's preparedness to enter the health science field. The exam takes approximately 209 minutes and includes 170 multiple-choice questions from the following content areas:

- Reading key ideas and details, craft and structure, integration of knowledge and ideas
- · Math numbers and algebra, measurement and data
- Science human anatomy and physiology, life and physical sciences, scientific reasoning
- English conventions of standard English, knowledge of the language, vocabulary acquisition

Test Prep
