In Memory of George C. Barber, MD

St. Claire HealthCare is deeply saddened by the passing of our friend and longtime colleague George C. Barber, MD. Dr. Barber served as a family physician in Morehead for 41 years. As one of the first physicians at St. Claire Regional Medical Center in 1963, he treated generations of families throughout our region.

A Morgan County native, Dr. Barber was a University of Kentucky honor graduate. He earned his medical degree at Wake Forest University and completed a rotating internship at Wm. Beaumont Army Medical Center in Texas. Upon completion of a residency in aviation medicine with the Air Force, he served as a flight surgeon with the US Army.

Dr. Barber was the second Chief of Staff at St. Claire from 1965-1967 and again from 1973-1975. He was Department of Medicine Chair from 1971-1974 and on Active Medical Staff from 1963-1997, and then became a Courtesy member. Dr. Barber was also appointed to the founding Board of Directors for the St. Claire Foundation.

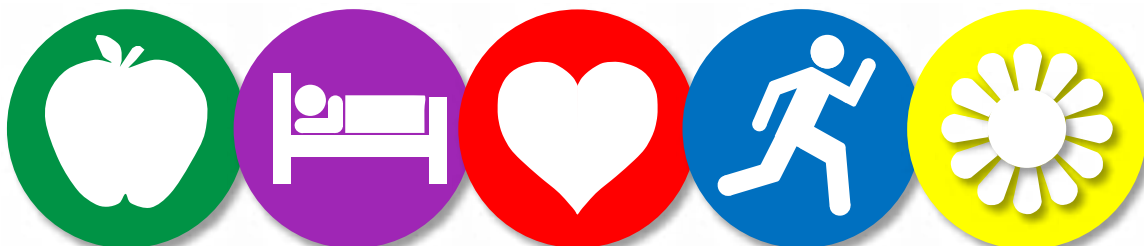
