The Clinical Documentation Improvement team recently attended the Nuance annual user group meeting in Chicago. Angela Craft submitted a summary of our Clinical Documentation Improvement program results since 2013. Based on the results, SCR was recognized with a Customer Impact Award! The team has worked very hard to achieve these results.

Some of the highlights include:

- Average Case Mix Index of 1.60 in FY 2016, coming from a baseline of 1.32 in 2013. This results in a financial impact of \$1.1M. Our CMI now reflects the appropriate level of severity of illness and risk of mortality.
- Physician response rate to clarifications is 100%.
 This shows the medical staff continue to support the program.
- We maintain necessary communications with patient caregivers from the point of entry through the billing process.
- We continue to educate the entire team on new strategies and opportunities.


