Matera is among a national network of more than 1,500 volunteer physicians who are responsible for providing leadership and direction to establish, maintain and support their facilities' cancer programs. Matera, who has a significant interest in the diagnosis and treatment of patients with malignant diseases, is a member of the multidisciplinary cancer committee at SCR.

Cancer liaison physicians are responsible for evaluating, interpreting and reporting their facilities' performance data through the National Cancer Data Base (NCDB) and facilitating quality improvement initiatives based on data findings. In addition, cancer liaison physicians lead the Commission on Cancer (CoC) initiatives within the cancer program and collaborate with agencies such as the American Cancer Society on behalf of the hospital. The CoC collects data from its accredited cancer programs and provides tools for these programs to facilitate analysis of patterns of diagnosis, treatment and quality of care for patients treated at the hospital.
