

## Certified Nurses' Day



*Saturday, March 19*



Certified Nurses' Day is a day of recognition established by the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC) to celebrate the contribution of board certified nurses to the advancement of the nursing profession and to higher standards and better outcomes for patient care. Certification in nursing represents an example of professional credentialing and is a voluntary process undertaken by practicing nurses. This voluntary process validates knowledge, skills and abilities beyond the scope of RN licensure. According to the American Board of Nursing Specialties, specialty-nursing certification is considered THE standard by which the public recognizes quality of nursing care.

The Institute of Medicine's (IOM) 2010 report, *The Future of Nursing: Leading Change, Advancing Health*, recommended that leaders at the federal level, at schools of nursing, and in health care systems work together to increase the proportion of Registered Nurses with a baccalaureate degree in nursing (BSN) from 50% to 80% by 2020. The report clearly calls for nurses to assume primary responsibility for personal and professional growth. It urges nurses to continue individual education and opportunities that develop and advance leadership skills. Nurse leaders are charged with facilitating innovative strategies to increase quality of care and patient outcomes in a patient-centered care environment.



### A short literature review clearly demonstrates the importance for nursing certification:

- Certified nurses have demonstrated higher knowledge of care related to pressure ulcers (Zulkowski, Ayello & Wexler, 2007) and familiarity with cancer care guidelines (Coleman, et al., 2009).
- Nurse supervisors have rated certified nurses, with higher performance scores for education/ collaboration, care planning, and evaluation compared to non-certified nurses (Redd & Alexander, 1997).
- Certified nurses have reported their perception that certification demonstrates professional growth and credibility (American Board of Nursing Specialties, 2006).
- Kendall-Gallagher, Aiken, Sloane, and Cimiotti (2011), in a study found a 2% decrease in the odds of patients dying associated with every 10% increase in the number of certified BSN nurses employed at a hospital. The same results were found for failure to rescue.
- Krapohl, Manojlovich, Redman, and Zhang (2010) found a positive relationship between specialty certification and the nurse's perception of empowerment. When nurses feel empowered, patient advocacy increases.
- A positive association between ICU nurses certified and a lower rate of reported falls and a lower rate of failure to rescue was found by Kendall-Gallagher & Blegen (2009).
- A study by Nelson et.al, (2007) found a statistically significant relationship between a unit's having a higher percentage of nurses who are certified rehabilitation registered nurses and a decreased length of stay.

St. Claire Regional supports nursing certification by reimbursing nurses for the cost of the examination in addition to paying for review courses and certification study course materials prior to the exam. If you are not certified, please consider attaining this important milestone in your career. The journey to certification is a pathway to increased knowledge, growth and development.

# St. Claire Regional recognizes Patient Safety



St. Claire Regional (SCR) continues our commitment to patient safety by recognizing Patient Safety Awareness Week March 13-19, in collaboration with the National Patient Safety Foundation. At SCR, we firmly believe that “every day is patient safety day.”

When healthcare providers and organizations put safety first, everyone benefits. SCR enhances patient safety by having interdisciplinary rounding occur at bedsides in specific units. This gives patients the opportunity to be more actively involved in their care, and allows the patient to ask questions and bring concerns to the attention of their healthcare team in a timely manner.

In January 2016, SCR’s “8 Points of Rounding Campaign” kicked off with nursing staff focusing on more purposeful time spent with their patients. This approach to rounding provides an opportunity to improve the quality of the Hourly Rounding interaction between our staff and patients, in order to establish more of a connection with our patients and improve safety. Purposeful Hourly Rounding has been shown to improve patient satisfaction and pain control, and decrease falls.

The goal of SCR’s Hourly Rounding program is to provide an even more meaningful patient interaction by:

- Ensuring that they are consistently comfortable
- Anticipating their personal needs
- Talking with them about their plan for the day, in addition to their treatment and discharge plans
- Offering assistance with typical patient requests before they are made

Additionally, SCR recently installed new white boards in patient rooms to improve communication, which also helps to increase patient safety. The boards make it easier to display and communicate important information, such as the names of the care team members, the patient’s plan of care or goals for the day, tests and treatments, dietary status, pain information and important contact numbers.

SCR also continues to address patient safety concerns by involving staff in SWARMS. A SWARM is a type of root cause analysis conducted in a blame-free, protected environment, providing an opportunity to candidly share concerns for patient safety and insights, or ideas for appropriate identification of system opportunities to improve care.

Remember, it takes an entire organization to provide the safest care for each person who chooses to make SCR their healthcare provider. Ask yourself today, “What am I contributing and how can I be more effective in my role to provide a safe patient experience for every patient, every time?”

# Mark J. Neff elected as board chair for EDC

Mark J. Neff, President and CEO of St. Claire Regional (SCR), was recently elected chair of the board of directors of the Morehead-Rowan County Economic Development Council Inc., for calendar year 2016.

He succeeds Wayne D. Andrews, president of Morehead State University, who served three years.

“This is an excellent opportunity to be more personally involved with efforts to grow and sustain our local economy,” said Neff. “The EDC has a vitally important role in coordinating all of our community resources for economic development.”

Neff said he is pleased that Terry W. Ensor, EDC’s interim executive director, has agreed to stay on through the end of 2016.

“Terry is going to help us find a new, full-time, permanent director by the end of the year,” Neff added.

Ensor has been holding the job on a temporary basis since mid-2014. He retired in July 2013 as an area president of Whitaker Bank.

In addition to the city, county and SCR, the EDC is comprised of representatives of the Morehead Tourism Commission, Morehead-Rowan County Industrial Development Authority, Morehead State University, Morehead-Rowan County Chamber of Commerce and

Maysville Community and Technical College.

As an “umbrella” agency in the form of a nonprofit corporation, the EDC provides logistical and staff support to the Morgan-Menifee-Rowan County Industrial Development Authority and the Morehead-Rowan County Industrial

Development Authority. Physical resources include the John Will Stacy MMRC Regional Business Park and the Morehead-Rowan County Aviation Business Park, both on KY 801 near I-64.

The EDC also works with the Morehead-Rowan County Chamber of Commerce to promote retail business development, and with the tourism commission to enhance Morehead and Rowan County as travel destinations for visitors.

## Extreme Makeover: *St. Claire Regional Edition*

As we approach our 53<sup>rd</sup> birthday, St. Claire Regional Medical Center is getting a facelift.

Technicians with Nawkaw – a company based in Athens, Georgia that specializes in masonry restoration and architectural staining – are giving the entire exterior of the medical center a thorough cleaning. They’re also staining the beige brick portions to match the existing red brick of the original hospital building.

During planning for the new medical office pavilion, it was noted that there were companies that offered brick staining services. Planners decided it would be nice for the exteriors of the new building, the medical center and the CHER Building to complement one another.

The project began on March 2 and is expected to take approximately three months to complete, according to Joe Planck, SCR’s Project Coordinator for Facilities Management.

Nawkaw’s stain work is guaranteed not to chip or fade for 25 years, at a cost much more affordable than other brick-staining companies that SCR considered, Planck said. And because it’s stain and not paint, it won’t peel.

During this process, patient care areas are advised to keep window blinds closed when technicians are scaling the building in their vicinity to ensure patient privacy.
