## St. Claire Regional Medical Pavilion

The new Medical Pavilion will bring many of St. Claire Regional's (SCR) provider services together under one roof.

The community will benefit greatly from the consolidation of SCR's services into a single campus, making it easier and more convenient for patients to transition from physician offices and outpatient support services in the Medical Pavilion to diagnostic care in the main hospital. Providers will also benefit from the renovation, as it will enable them to quickly travel between their personal offices and the hospital as needed. Additionally, the new Medical Pavilion will allow SCR to make more efficient use of shared exam rooms, offices and support spaces.

### **Located on SCR's main campus, the Medical Pavilion will include the following services:**

- Cardiology
- Gastroenterology
- General/Vascular Surgery
- Internal Medicine
- Neurology
- Medical Oncology
- Orthopedics
- Pulmonology
- Urology
- Physical Therapy
- Oncology Infusion Center
- UK Women's HealthCare
- Radiology/Laboratory Services
- Pharmacy
- Telemedicine Center
- Education Space

The Medical Pavilion is ultimately a consolidation of St. Claire Regional's Cave Run Surgical Specialists and Morehead Medical Specialists, and UK Women's HealthCare Morehead. It will contain outpatient services, classifying it as a business occupancy. The actual structure will be an 81,000-square-foot steel-framed building with a flat roof and three stories, all above ground. The exterior will be comprised of a combination of glass curtain walls, metal panels and masonry wall construction, with a membrane roof.

The Old Second Street Access Road will separate the Medical Pavilion from the main hospital. The design includes an elevated pedway connector from the second floor of the existing hospital to an upper floor of the Medical Pavilion. An exterior canopy will provide a covered drop-off for visitors to the facility, and an additional entry will allow direct access from the adjoining surface parking lot.

The location of the Medical Pavilion will be at the corner of SCR's campus near the intersection of Flemingsburg Road and West Second Street — prominent thoroughfares used by the local community and the students at nearby Morehead State University. As SCR's campus building closest to the street, the Pavilion will be highly visible and present the most prominent facades to passersby.

# Getting to know SCR's longest-serving volunteer, *Mildred Stanley*

If you're a staff member at St. Claire Regional, you probably know Mildred Stanley — even if she doesn't know you.

Mildred, who will turn 87 years young this year, has been a volunteer at SCR for 32 years. She and her late husband, Johnny Stanley, moved from Mississippi to Morehead, Kentucky, in 1964. He served as a professor at Morehead State University, while Mildred held a position in the university's library for nearly 20 years.

Mildred may have retired from MSU in December of 1983, but she has never stopped working. Less than a month after her retirement, on Jan. 4, 1984, she decided to try volunteering at SCR after a suggestion from a friend. "And I've been here ever since," she said.

Mildred says her favorite part about volunteering is getting out and meeting people. "I enjoy it, I really do," she said. "I have made a lot of friends here."
